Q: What kind of photo should I use?

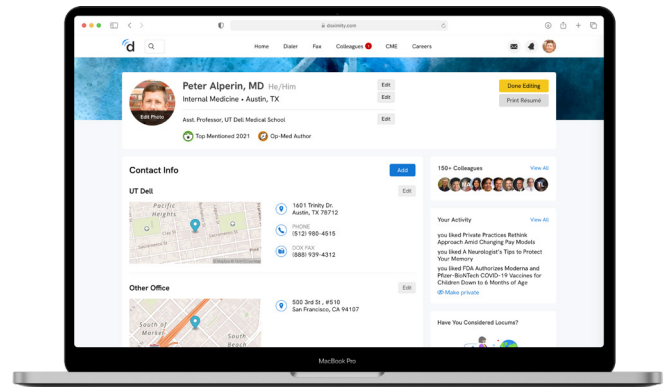
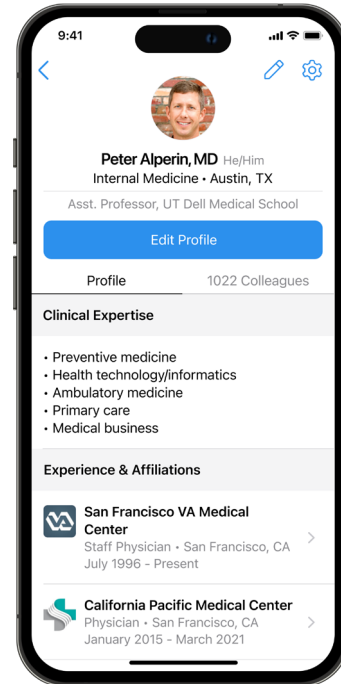
A: We recommend a professional headshot for your profile. It's visible not only to referring physicians but to patients as well. You can change your photo during registration, or by editing your profile at any time.

Q: What is a private line?

A: The "private line" field is only visible to other clinicians you have accepted as "colleagues." By providing your private line, you ensure colleagues can reach you easily.

Q: What fields are the most important to update?

A: We recommend updating as much profile information as possible so referring physicians have the most accurate information about you. Doximity will automatically populate some information for you and periodically update your profile. Profiles see an average of 30 automatic updates per year, including new publications and press mentions.
